Questions

1. Briefly share one idea from Shaen's message that stuck out to you today?
2. The MAIN IDEA was: In difficult times, wait on the Lord who is in control of all things.
 - What are some challenges that we, as human beings, face when waiting on the Lord in difficult times?
3. Daniel's first response to the vision was **to weep for the lost**.
 - When life gets hard for you, do you tend to pull inward and just focus on your circumstances, or do you continue serving others in the midst of your difficulty?
4. Do you find it easier or more difficult to share the good news with others in personal times of challenge?
5. Daniel's second response to the vision was to **go to work**.
 - When life gets really challenging, are you able to find joy and move forward or do you tend to want to pull back and shut down?
 - Honest question...does the joy of our salvation vary based on our life circumstances? briefly explain!
6. Daniel's final response was to **live in the mystery**.
 - Do you enjoy mystery and thrive in it, or do you struggle with mystery and try to avoid it?
 - What are some practical steps we can take to show God that we are fully surrendered to Him and we trust Him with our future?
7. What is one practical action step you need to take in your own life this week in light of what you learned from Daniel 8 today?
