

On Mission: Being equipped to share

Scripture: Ephesians 4:11-12

First Church Mission: A community of unfinished people being equipped to share the hope of Jesus in a broken world.

Questions

1. Read Ephesians 4:11-12 and review our Church's mission. What are your initial thoughts on this scripture and our mission?
2. Share if you have experienced or seen where a Christian's "walk" did not match their "talk". How did it hinder or even hurt the Gospel?
3. Look at the person on your left. Share a discipleship strength that you have observed in their Christian walk.
4. Two things need to happen to be built up into better and brighter disciples. First, "Leaders need to equip". How have our current leaders or leaders from your past impacted you and equipped you or your family?
5. Second, "You must serve."
 - God gives us gifts to serve where he leads our heart. What is the hardest part about stepping into a new area of service?
 - Share a time when you were impacted by a big or small act of service by a Christian or group of Christians. Why has that action remained in your memory?
 - Share a time you served someone individually or as a group and the blessing you received by being obedient.
6. Where is God calling you to disciple?
7. End in prayer thanking God for the opportunities we have to be equipped and then put it into service.
