Discussion Questions

What has challenged you, changed you or confused you from this week's sermon or the book of Jude?

1. Read Jude 2.
 - What would it look to have mercy multiplied in your life?
 - How about peace multiplied to you?
 - Or love multiplied to you?
2. Read Jude 3.
 - What does it mean to "contend" for the faith?
 - How does it change depending on what kind of person you're talking to? For example, read the description in Jude 12, 16, 18-19. How is contending with these individuals different than say, perhaps, the woman at the well in John 4?
 - What is confession?
 - What are some underlying principles from Scripture that guide how we contend for the faith? (For instance, check out 1 Peter 3:15-16)
3. How do you discern what matters are worth contending/fighting for, and which matters can be in the "agree to disagree" category?
4. Read Jude 17-23.
 - List the things Jude calls believers to do in these verses
 - What would abiding in death look like?
 - Is the Holy Spirit convicting you, challenging you, or comforting you regarding any of those?

Read Jude 24-25. Spend some time in prayer worshipping our great God!
