Also: Isaiah 30:18; Psalm 16:1-2, 5-6, 11; Colossians 2:9-10; 1 Corinthians 1:23-25; Psalm 51:8-13; Psalm 30

Discussion Questions

What has challenged you, changed you or confused you from this week's sermon or the Scripture passages?

- 1. Read Isaiah 30:18
 - What does it teach us about God?
 - What is behind the Lord showing mercy?
 - Are you in a season of waiting on God? If so, how?
- 2. Read Psalm 16:11. This seems to be the kind of Hebrew poem where each line is asserting a different facet of the same thing.
 - **How does your life reflect this verse?** (How does your life reflect that God has made known the path of life, which is fullness of joy in His presence, which means pleasures forevermore!)
- 3. In the sermon, the point was made that we get our identity from God, not from people.
 - What things might you have a tendency to find identity in?
 - How have those things held up? Or proven false?
- 4. Read through Matthew 16:13-19, where Jesus gives Simon a new name.
 - Imagine being Simon in this scene. How do you think a name change like that would've felt?
 - How would it have impacted you?
 - In what ways has God given you a new name? (Chosen, Redeemed, Adopted, etc).

May your true rest be rooted in your identity in Jesus!
