- **Change Me First** – Leaders go first and last. Spirit, what do you want to change in me to make me a more effective witness for you? (*More love? More tact? More boldness? Etc!*)
- **Your Kingdom Come, Your Will Be Done** – look around the corner. Addicted to the predictable. What do you, Spirit, want to transform in and around me today? Not just an incremental change, but turn upside down?
- **May hate and Division be replaced by Grace and Truth.** What do I need to forgive? Who do I need to choose to love and show grace toward? What fences do I need to mend?
- **We need Miracles** – Pray for miracles. Every miracle begins with a problem. What problems do I have where I need a miracle?
