## Discussion Questions

1. What has challenged you, changed you or confused you from this week's sermon or the Scriptures in it?
2. If you picture yourself in the story, where would you be (out of the following options), & why?
  - One of His disciples helping with the preparations? One of those questioning what's going on? One of those welcoming Him along the road? One of the Pharisees trying to stop the praise?
  - What causes you to pick that for yourself?
3. Read Zechariah 9:9. What was Jesus' saying when He orchestrated His entry into Jerusalem the way He did?
  - What are the implications of this? (For the disciples? For the people? For the religious & political leaders?)
  - What are the implications of this for you?
4. What does it say about Jesus that He received the people's praise?
5. What act(s) of praise might the Spirit be prompting you to offer this week as you prepare for Easter?
