Also: 2 Corinthians 5:14; John 1:12

## Discussion Questions

1. What has challenged you, changed you or confused you from this week's sermon or the Scriptures in it?
2. What are some things (events, food, people, etc) that you like to include in your celebration of Easter?
3. This week's sermon broke down the angel's message into several components:
  - He has risen!
  - Come and see the place
  - Go quickly and tell
  - You will see Him
    - This Easter, which of those is resonating with you most, and why?
    - How can you let that thought simply be present with you this week? Not another thing you need to do, just let the thought dwell in you throughout the coming days?
4. Jesus' resurrection makes Christianity unique. Think of the contrast between faith resting on something we do vs. faith resting on something Jesus has done:
  - What thoughts and feelings come out of that contrast?
  - Why do you think we as humans gravitate towards one or the other?
5. What are some of the way the resurrection of Jesus has:
  - Shaped the world?
  - Shaped your life in particular?
6. Spend some time thanking Him for being the Way!
