## **Discussion Questions**

- 1. What has challenged you, changed you or confused you from this week's sermon or the Scriptures in it?
- 2. When you hear the phrase, "For God So Loved the World†what do you think of?
- 3. How does the Good News about Jesus show us God's great love? (I know this is basic, but still good to pause on!)
  - How has the Gospel changed your life?
  - How is the Gospel still changing your life? Not just in the past, at the moment of salvation; I want you to think about His ongoing transformation of your life into the image of Christ.
- 4. During the sermon, the point "God does not love us because we are valuable. We are valuable because God loves us†was made
  - How does that impact you?
  - o How is that relevant for our culture?
  - Does that statement reflect how you treat other people?
- 5. The Gospel's great gift gives eternal life.
  - What is the nature of eternal life?
  - Is it all just in the future?
  - Consider John 3:36; 5:24 and 6:47. The focus of eternal life is not on our future, but on our current standing in Christ.
  - The Bible inextricably links eternal life with the Person of Jesus Christ. See verse 3 of Jesus' prayer in John 17.
- 6. How much does the idea of eternal life impact your daily life?
