Discussion Questions

- 1. What has challenged you, changed you or confused you from this week's sermon or the Scriptures in it?
- 2. In the sermon, the big point was, "Anytime you say yes to God, Satan will oppose you."
 - What are some of the implications of that statement?
 - What does that mean about suffering?
 - o About God's love for us?
 - How does that impact your perspective on your life?
- 3. The Israelites who were following Nehemiah and rebuilding the wall faced all kinds of difficulty: anger, mocking, threats, fatigue, skepticism, fear
 - Can you identify with them?
 - When feeling that way, what else suffers? (Could be marriage relationship, work ethic, friendships, integrity, etc.)
- 4. What were some of the "combat tools" pointed to in the sermon?
 - They kept praying
 - They kept at it (perseverance)
 - They stayed watchful
 - They remembered the Lord
- 5. Which of those do you need right now?
 - What do you need to think/do about it?
- 6. Is there a friend or loved one who needs one of those right now?
 - What can you do to help them? (Pray, send a card/text, have a conversation, etc.)
