Scripture: Genesis 1:1-3

Also – Isaiah 5:20; Psalm 13:1-6, 139:7-16; Romans 5:10; Hebrews 1:1-3; John 1:12, 12:35-36

Discussion Questions

1. What has challenged you, changed you or confused you from this week's sermon or the Scriptures in it?
2. Can you describe a time when you were in darkness? Either the utter spiritual darkness of life apart from Jesus, or figurative darkness?
3. Read Psalm 139. What truths about God from that Psalm would bring comfort for someone in a season of darkness?
4. When you've been in a season of figurative darkness, what have you done to find your way out? Try to avoid the "call on Jesus" answer! It's true, but practically, what are some tangible ways you turn to Jesus?
5. Have you ever been a part of helping someone out of the darkness?
6. Is there anyone around you that is struggling in the darkness, and is looking for a way out? Is there a way you can walk alongside them in it?
7. In what way has Christmas pierced your darkness?
8. During this season of Christmas, is there someone (who may be in the dark) that you could share your story with?

May we live this season reflecting the light of Jesus!
