Discussion Questions

1. What has challenged you, changed you or confused you from this week's sermon or the Scriptures in it?
2. Jesus came to bring life; in John 10:10 He says he came to bring *abundant* life.
 - o How would you describe abundant life?
 - o Are you living it? Why or why not?
 - o What detracts from it?
 - o What contributes to it?
3. In the sermon, the points were made that through His life, we have a path, power, and a plan.
 - o How have you seen those play out in your life?
 - o In others/the life of the church?
 - o Where have you seen a lack of those?
4. Jesus came to bring light.
 - o How has Jesus illuminated your life in the past?
 - o How does He continue to do so?
 - o Are there any places where you would like to shut out His light? What causes you to feel that way?
5. Where is the Spirit urging you into the light?
6. Read Matthew 5:14-16
 - o As people around you observe you, how do you think they would observe your light? Is it bright and powerful? Irritating or illuminating? Weak and dim? Gentle or garish? Etc.?
 - o Is there anything you need to change about your reflection of Jesus' light?
