Questions

1. What has challenged you, changed you or confused you from this week's sermon or the Scriptures in it?
2. Jesus was born in the real world. A world filled with politics, harshness, and tyranny.
 - How is that similar to our current world?
 - How is that dissimilar to our current world?
3. Politics, harshness and tyranny work to erode people's hope:
 - Where do you see a need for hope in our world?
 - Who do you see around you that needs hope?
 - What is one thing you could do to be a channel of hope for them?
4. Jesus was born into this world to bring real joy, salvation, real peace.
 - How are those elements visible in your life this season?
 - If you pause and reflect for a few moments, what could you use more of?
5. How do the real events of Jesus' coming provide an anchor for your faith?
6. How does Jesus' birth (as well as His life, death, burial and resurrection) anchor your hope for the future?
7. How do those same events give you an opportunity to talk with others about your faith?
