Scripture: Mark 11:27-12:12

Questions

1. Read Mark 11:12-26
2. What has challenged you or changed you from this week's sermon or the Scriptures in it?
3. What questions do you have or where do you want to dig in a little deeper?
4. How are you with control? Do you find yourself overcontrolling things or are you generally more trusting and can relinquish control?
5. Is there an area of your life you find yourself not surrendering to Jesus? What keeps you from surrendering it and trust it to Jesus?
6. What in your life do you need to trust is in the hands of Jesus? Maybe it's a person or a situation?
7. When it comes to the sin in your life, is your response typically faith and good works or faith and living/remaining in condemnation?
8. Take some time to pray for each other that you would truly grasp the depth of God's love and grace for each of us. Maybe use Ephesians 2:16-19 as a way to pray for each other.
 - "I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge - that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God."
