Questions

- 1. Read Mark 14:1-11
- 2. What challenged you in the sermon this week that you want to talk about more deeply?
- 3. In what ways do we give Jesus less than the totality of our adoration and worship?
- 4. Are you naturally an "all in" type of person, or a cautious person? What are the benefits or pitfalls of both?
- 5. In Mark 9:24 the father of a demon-possessed son says to Jesus, "I believe, help me in my unbelief." Can you be "all in" and still have some doubts? Why or why not?
- 6. The woman gave her most precious possession to worship Jesus. How might we be too reserved in our worship and devotion of God?
- 7. How does worship driven by love look different than driven by another motive?
- 8. As we pour ourselves into our family, friends, and good works, how do we reorient these to keep Christ at the top?
- 9. We adore and worship Jesus as our Savior. How do we present Jesus to those who view Him as a killjoy or a bunch of rules?
- 10. In seeing Jesus as her Savior, the woman in Mark 14 did what she could (vs 8). How might we be waiting to do something "great" for Jesus and be missing what we could do today?
- 11. What one change could you make today that would enhance your adoration and worship for Jesus?
- 12. Spend some time praying for each other that God would help us adore him more deeply.
