7. Have you ever thought of God as "daddy", "abba father"? What does it mean to be a child of the King? Describe the intimacy of a father-child relationship? Is it attainable with your Heavenly Father?
8. Would you like to share the thoughts you have while taking communion?
9. During communion what is something that you find yourself focusing on the most? Why?
10. Spend a few minutes praying for the needs represented in your group.
