

Gospel Truths / The Gospel Changes Me - Week 4 - No Jesus, No Gospel

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 5:16-21

Questions

1. What challenged you in the sermon this week? Or what questions do you have that you want to dig into further?
2. The gospel is all about Jesus Christ. In your own words, put together your understanding of the Gospel. What is the Gospel? If you are comfortable, share it with the group.
3. What is your personal view of Christ? Consider in your group why Jesus cannot be simply a good teacher or a good man.
4. Why is it necessary for us to allow Christ to change us from the inside out and not just our circumstances?
5. Our position in Christ creates a new person! 2 Corinthians 5:17 says, "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come, the old is gone!" Spend some time on these questions: How are you a new creation in Christ? Name some characteristics of the "old" you and how they have been replaced by your life in Christ. Share what the "new" you is like.
6. Describe what an "ambassador" is. What is an ambassador for Christ in your situation?
7. Practice sharing your faith story - how has your relationship with Jesus Christ changed your life? Why is this an effective way of sharing the gospel?
8. Spend some time praying together as a group. For various needs, but also that God would help each of us be ambassadors for Christ.
