

The Minor Prophets - Week 10

Scripture: Micah 6:1-8

Questions

1. Read the text and open in prayer that God will impress on your hearts His wisdom and understanding.
2. In verse 8, God summarizes the entire law to Israel in one sentence. What are the benefits of knowing the character of God? Why does it matter?
3. In verse 1, court is in session and Israel has been charged with being unfaithful to God. Would you plead guilty or innocent of the same charge? How can your relationship with God change your plea?
4. Verses 3-5 tell us why Israel can trust God to redeem them from certain condemnation. What about the new testament church? What evidence is there in our lifetime that God is working out our salvation?
5. Verses 6 & 7 represent how some believers respond to God's call to be more like Him. In what ways can we live that exhibits an attitude that living a Godly life is just too hard?
6. Pastor Shaen said that it is impossible to do the first two things (act justly & love mercy) if you are not walking humbly with God. How does pride damage our relationship with God? How does it damage our relationships with others?
7. Share a story of a faithful Christian who has walked humbly in their faith and how it has impacted your faith.
8. To "Act Justly" is to live with integrity (morality) and honesty. How does the lack of these attributes in a Christian's life impact their good deeds and witness of Christ to others?
9. To "Love Mercy" encompasses kindness, forgiveness, love and grace to all of those around us. How do we demonstrate these attributes to those who are hurtful without becoming a casualty of their abuse?
10. Close in prayer asking God to show you where you need to grow in obedience that others may see God's character in us.
