Scripture: Nahum

Questions

1. Let's pray and ask the Holy Spirit to come speak to us to help us grasp the greatness of the God that we serve.
2. Someone read the passage from the Sermon today Nahum 1:1-15.
3. This week's sermon is a very important concept to grasp to understand what we read about God in the Bible. What are some instances in the Bible where God's Both/And have stuck out to you?
4. "God is Both/and in His Being" - What does it make you feel when you hear that God is a jealous God? What about a Slow to anger or patient God? Why?
5. "God is Both/And in His Actions" - Do you believe that God has the right to not just create but also destroy?
6. "God is Both Destroyer of His enemies and Redeemer to His People" - In order for us to fully appreciate God's Redemption we need to understand how fully we deserve destruction. How do we help others who don't know God understand this fact?
7. We learned today about God's patience to Nineveh but eventual vengeance and destruction. If we stopped right there then it can be a harsh but fair tale. But the story doesn't end there, in Matt 12:41 (Have someone read the verse) What does Jesus's inclusion of Nineveh in this passage tell you about God's ultimate love and plan for all people?
