Questions

1. Read Malachi 3:7
2. What questions do you have about the sermon or places where you want to spend time in deeper discussion?
3. When you think of the word obedience, what comes to mind? Does obedience have a more negative or positive connotation for you? Why?
4. Obedience in our worship can be a very broad principle. What are some ways God might be calling us to be more obedient in our worship, or to turn to him in the way we worship? Note: this isn't necessarily just musical worship. It's all the ways in which we can worship Jesus with our lives.
5. Obedience in giving can be a touchy subject. How have you seen God do a work in your heart through your giving and generosity?
6. What do you think C.S. Lewis meant when he said, "I do not believe one can settle how much we are to give. I am afraid the only safe rule is to give more than we can spare."
7. Obedience when God seems silent - have you had moments in your life when God seemed silent? If you feel comfortable, can you describe the circumstances surrounding that season?
8. What are some ways you sought to remain faithful and obedient during that season where God seemed silent?
9. In the end, the ultimate form of obedience is to surrender to Jesus. Following him is what leads to life. In what ways can you testify that choosing to be obedient to Jesus is the best way to live? It is choosing life!
10. Spend some time praying for the needs of one another.
